

Dr. Fabrizio Pregliasco is Researcher at the Department of Biomedical Sciences for Health at the University of Milan, Italy.

Biographical summary

Dr. Pregliasco studied medicine and surgery at the University of Milan, Italy.

After graduating with distinction in 1986, he specialized in Hygiene, Preventive Medicine and Toxicology and has worked since 1991 as University Researcher in General and Applied Hygiene at the former Institute of Virology, University of Milan.

Since 1995/1996 he lectures on “Hygiene and Preventive Medicine” of the Faculty of Medicine and Surgery at the University of Milan.

Apart from the above mentioned activities, he pursues a public welfare job as Health Director of the Foundation Institute “Sacra Famiglia” in Cesano Boscone, Milan, a facility for rehabilitation and treatment of disabled persons since 2015, actually is Medical Director of IRCCS Istituto Galeazzi di Milano.

He was also a member of the European Influenza Surveillance Scheme (E.I.S.S.).

Since 1989 to date he held positions in the organs of ANPAS (Associazione Nazionale Pubbliche Assistenze), National President from 2013 to date (www.anpas.org).

Publications, special interests and activities

Dr Pregliasco is currently engaged in studying the aetiological, epidemiological and preventive aspects of some viral diseases, in particular influenza, hepatitis, and infections caused by poliovirus and retrovirus. Further studies deal with the evaluation of the efficacy of vaccines and drugs for influenza and the epidemiological course of influenza in Italy. His research activities include collaboration in 12 clinical trials on antiviral vaccines and drugs, carried out in accordance with the principles of Good Laboratory Practice (GLP) and Good Clinical Practice (GCP). 168 full-length publications in national and international journals as well as participation in numerous conferences of national and international importance give evidence of his scientific activities.
