She was responsible for the conference of the Federation of European Toxicological Societies, which took place in 2003 in Florence.

The activity of Prof. Marinovich focused mainly on the identification of mechanisms of toxicity operating at the cellular and molecular level with particular reference to the central nervous system and the immune system, characterizing the relationship between biochemical changes and cell death, using different biological systems and analysing different pictures of cell damage and death.
Author of more than 120 publications in peer-reviewed international journals in the field of drug-toxicology and editor of several volumes in Italian and English.
