
Using EPM to Elevate Privileges and Install Applications on UniSID Devices


The **EPM (Endpoint Privilege Management)** feature complements the range of installable applications on UniSID devices, already available on the Corporate Portal, which remains the reference point for university applications, as they are verified and secure.

Using EPM, users can autonomously install and/or run applications that require administrative privileges, including both executable files (.exe) and Microsoft Installer packages (.msi).

How to Install an Application with EPM

- 1. Right-click on the application you want to run and select Properties.
- 2. Check if the application is **blocked**.








3. If the screen shows the option **Unblock**, the app is blocked: Activate the **Unblock** checkbox and click **OK**.



4. Right-click again on the application and, from the context menu, click on "Run with elevated privileges":




On Windows 11 systems, this option may be hidden under "Show more options".

Note: As shown in the previous images, do not click "Run as administrator".

5. When the text box appears, provide a brief note explaining the reason for using elevated privileges and confirm.




- 6. Enter your credentials to complete the elevation process.
- 7. End.

If "Run with elevated privileges" Is Missing

If the "Run with elevated privileges" option is not visible in the context menu:


1. Navigate to the folder "C:\Program Files\Microsoft EPM Agent\EPMShellExtension" and click on "EpmShellExtension.msix".

2. A window will appear confirming that the extension is already installed. Click "Reinstall".



3. After this, the "Run with elevated privileges" option should appear in the menu.
